Best Behaviour School for dogs

School Rules!

Dogs are collected from your home and taken to school, a field over an acre in size, to enjoy play and exercise for over an hour with other dogs. The exercise area is securely contained on all sides. School is run by Jen in the Hythe, Folkestone and Ashford area. Pick up times are roughly 8-9am and 12-1pm. Drop offs are 11-12pm and 3-4pm - dependent on routes.



The van is securely fitted with dog cages; all cages have rounded edges and have the appropriate security fastenings on the front. They are all lined with vet bed rubber matting that provide protection and are easy to keep hygienically clean.



Each dog has their own towel and will be rubbed down at the end of the run. Please send your dog to school with their lead. Water is always carried and dogs have constant access to water when playing in the field.

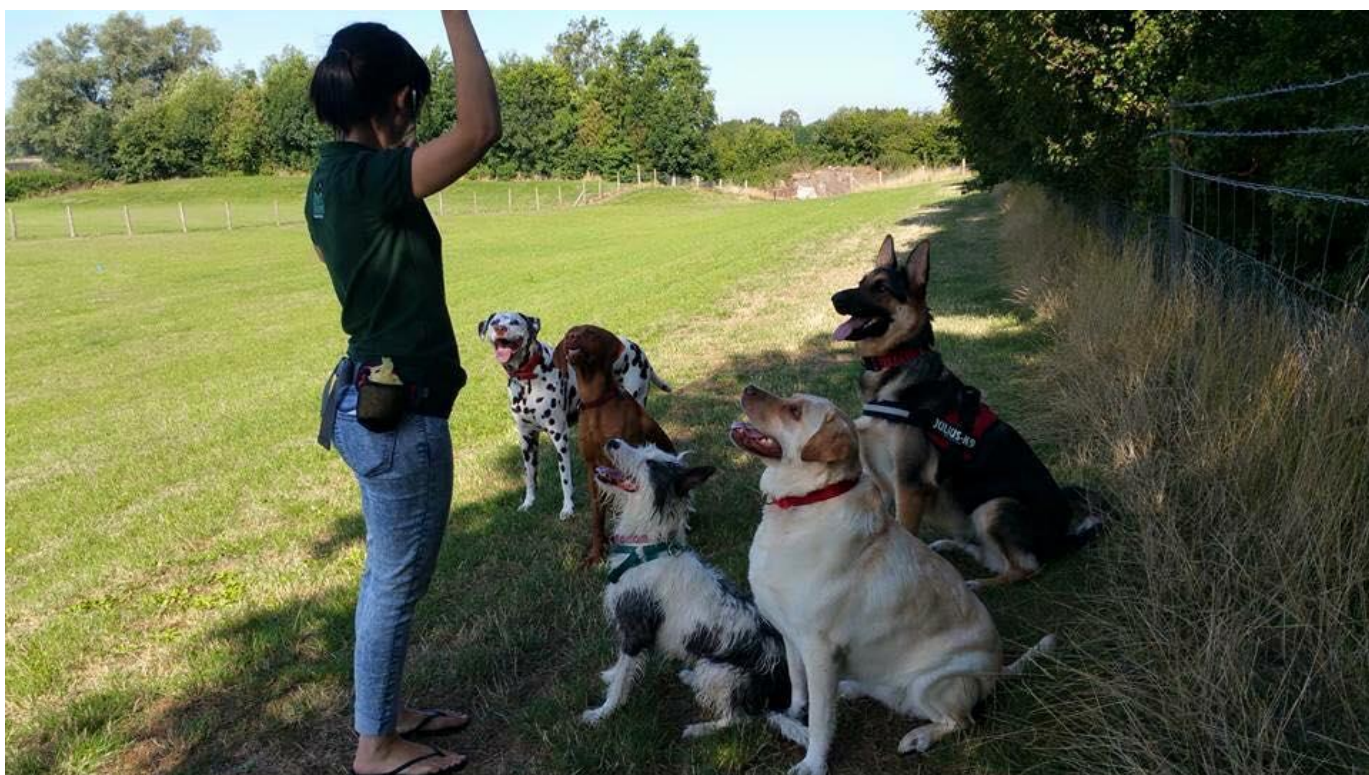
All dogs must be up to date with their annual vaccinations. This combines Distemper, Parvovirus, Infectious Canine Hepatitis and Leptospirosis. Ideally dogs should also receive the kennel cough vaccination as they will be mixing with other dogs.

Dogs should have eaten at least 2 hours before school as the excitement can upset tummies. Hypoallergenic treats are occasionally used with your prior permission.

Training time:

During school dogs are taught recall and heel work and are discouraged from jumping up:

However, fun and games are the primary focus and this is a far better portrayal of class; your dog can run to his heart's content and will be returned safely and happily exhausted (although maybe a little mucky!).



School Fees:

The cost of school is £20 per dog for a class. Dogs from the same household will receive a discounted rate. Fees can either be paid weekly or invoiced for the month you've had. Payment can be made in Cash on the day or Bank Transfer to our account.

Cancellation policy:

For cancellations notified by 10.00am on the previous day there will be no charge. Pre-paid fees will be carried forward to your next booking. For cancellations made after 10.00am on the previous day the full fee will become payable.

Neutering:

Uncastrated males will be accepted at dog school, subject to their behaviour in a mixed group setting. Females cannot attend while they are in season, due to the dramatic impact on both males and females. It is the owner's responsibility to inform us if their female has come into season.

Kennel Cough:

Not a subject we like to think about but we wanted to include a little note for awareness. Kennel Cough is the common term for an upper respiratory infection. Although not usually a serious threat to a healthy dog, it is extremely contagious; spread via direct contact, contaminated surfaces and air droplets. Unfortunately symptoms may only appear 5-10 days after exposure and affected dogs may develop a cough, may run a temperature or go off their food. If your dog is coughing, and you suspect Kennel Cough, please do not send your dog to school and notify us as soon as possible. We take every precaution to prevent the spread of communicable diseases such as this.

Flea Treatments:

Please could we ask you to keep on top of your dog's flea treatments and check them over regularly, not only for their wellbeing but also for the consideration of all the other dogs at school.
